

### Opportunities

- Availability in Arabic (developed and piloted in the region)
- > Linkages to referral systems and community based CP
- Targeting all sectors/integration/mainstreaming
- Almost all child protection issues are covered
- Focus on youth, practitioners, parents
- Increased focus on root causes (social norms, gender...)

## Challenges

- > Training and mentorship as prerequisites for implementation
- Capacity for technical support less than demand
- Staff turnover
- > MEAL
- Capacity for Technical Advisor to use all materials
