 To educate the general public about definitions, forms, risk factors and consequences of child abuse, and provide insight into developmentally appropriate child-rearing practices.

 To raise the capacity of other child rights and protection organizations nationally through exchange of experiences, education and training.


















Dar Al Amman (DAA)

Psychosocial Counseling

The counselors provide the cases (women suffering from GBV and children)with counseling and therapy.

- Support group.

Case Management services

Through partnerships with different organizations, the cases have access to legal assistance, protection services (police), and mentoring behavior(MOSD) within the same location.

- Strengthening social cohesion through implementing activities with the adolescents through peer education and various interactive trainings for women and adolescents that aim to enhance resilience.








Project Components:


- Comprehensive case management services for children and women.













