


Progress to date: Results and Funding

Child Protection and the 3RP





Key results



Outcome: Increased and more equitable access for boys and girls affected by the Syria crisis to quality child protection interventions

Output 1: Increased capacity of existing child protection systems and strengthened policy and legal framework for child protection

Output 2: Community-based child protection and psychosocial support interventions are available for girls and boys affected by the Syria crisis in targeted locations

Output 3: **Specialized child protection services** for girls and boys affected by the Syria crisis are available in targeted locations.


Output 4: **Enhanced evidence based advocacy and knowledge generation** on key child protection issues




Regional Result 1: CP and GBV Training






CP and SGBV Training: Sept 2016






Result 2: Community based CP and PSS






Community based CP and PSS Sept 2016








Specialised services: Sept 2016






CP funding so far 2016
